We are absolutely thrilled to offer a Photography Walk, as one of the Conference Spouses/Partners events. We're thinking more "photography" than "heritage", and ... some overlap will occur! As your guide, I provide photography-coaching (if asked). Maximum 10 participants.

Book early. Check back here periodically for updated information.

We will divide our time between indoor and outdoor locations, starting around Courthouse Square and then to Blockhouse Island and along the waterfront of Hardy Park.

Indoors at (some of):

1. St. Paul's Anglican Church
2. Wall Street United Church
3. First Baptist Church
4. First Presbyterian Church

The exact itinerary is under development.


Please stay together, especially for the indoor locations, which will have specific time bookings.

We are prepared to adapt to weather, and can work outside in a light drizzle.

(We may see freighter ships passing by!)

The general flow will be something like:

- 10:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.: 45 minutes in each of two indoors settings – explore the grounds around Courthouse Square
- 12:30 p.m. to 1:30 p.m.: bag lunch provided (pick up at a central location in the morning); we will arrange a bathroom break (possibly at Blockhouse Island)
- 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., tour the Brockville waterfront



Housekeeping:

- we will of course respect the generosity of the churches and others who have so enthusiastically allowed us entry;
- we expect that all participants will give free use (but not copyright!) of a small number of their best photographs to our hosts;
- accessibility: most of the locations are disability-friendly, not all — please inquire
 - the entire route *could* be walked in about 20 minutes, and travel by car is also an option (lots of parking)
- suggested: rain-shell, umbrella, sun-hat, sunscreen, snack and water

Safety:

- liability: we will be careful, but essentially you are responsible for your own safety; ctLow Photography explicitly declines any further responsibility; the Conference apparently has insurance
 - the pandemic continues, however much we might wish it otherwise — your guide is fully-vaccinated, and will wear a high-quality mask in indoor spaces, where we will also be i) beholden to the policies of the individual organizations, and ii) considerate towards the more cautious in our group
- If you cannot live with these moderate safety requirements, then please do not sign up.

Photography:

- tripod suggested, but *there is no equipment-standard for this tour*; assume no indoor flash
- plan for room on your memory-card, extra batteries
- if you have *specific learning goals*, then *please* feel very free to contact me ahead of time
- then, for the following week or so, we will (with individual permissions), share some of our work by email and get ideas from each other
- I will ask about sharing some of your work in my marketing, which will be entirely at your discretion
